	Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
One syllable	short old large hot big	shorter older larger hotter bigger	the shortest the oldest the largest the hottest the biggest
Two and more syllables	modern boring beautiful	more modern more boring more beautiful	the most modern the most boring the most beautiful
Ending on -y-	happy easy scary	happier easier scariest	the happiest the easier the scariest
!!! Irregular	good bad	better worse	the best the worst

 London is bigger than Oslo.
 This game is easier than tennis.
 My mother is younger than my father.*

*Russia is the largest country in the world
 This is the most boring film ever.
 Nigeria is the dirtiest country in the world.
