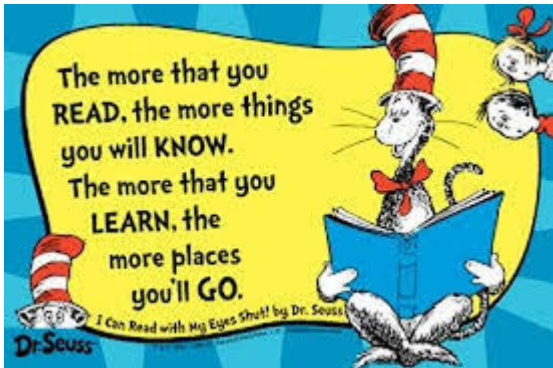


PROPÓSITO:

Good Readers

Determine Importance!

Good readers **ALWAYS** think while reading.

Good readers take notice of new learning.

Good readers decide what to remember and what to ignore.

Good readers decide what is **IMPORTANT** & what is **INTERESTING**.

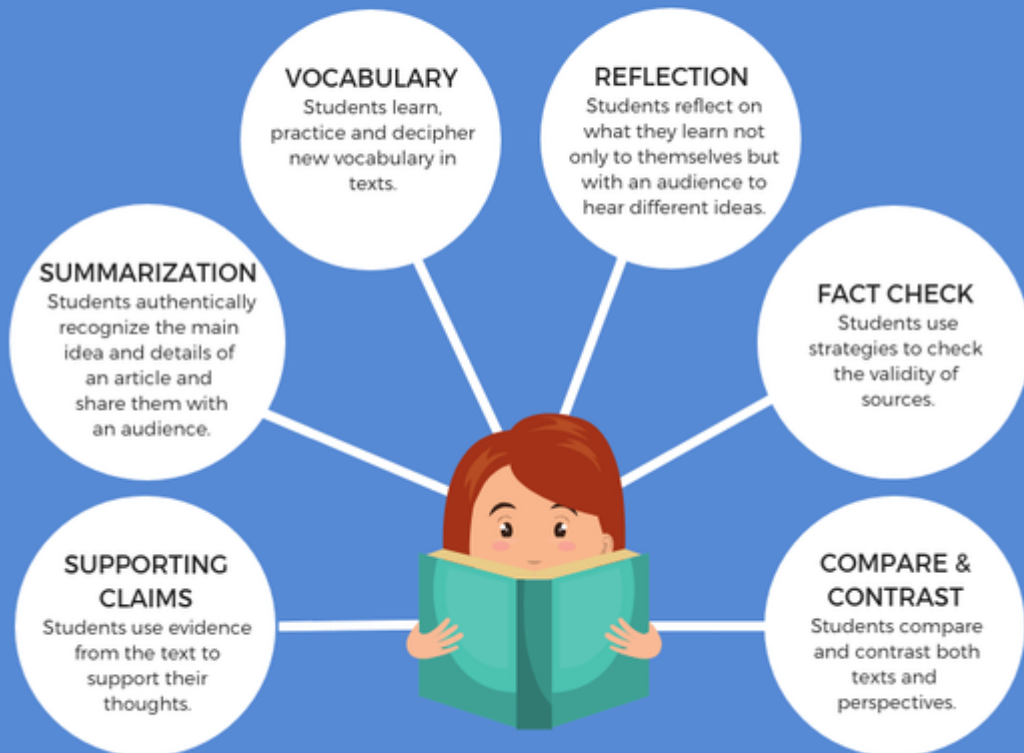
Good readers use text features to help them see what is important.

Good readers ask themselves questions while reading.

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READING COMPREHENSION SKILLS



Global project-based learning motivates students to develop critical reading comprehension skills as students collaborate together! PenPal Schools connect students from around the world with authentic reading and writing opportunities.

• Reading Comprehension Strategies •

- 1 Re-read for clarification.
- 2 Make predictions.
- 3 Make connections to prior knowledge or past experiences.
- 4 Ask questions or wonder about what's being described or taught.
- 5 Survey the text.
(Read the main headings, skip ahead, skim, read the first and last paragraphs of a section.)
- 6 Take notes.
- 7 Visualize what is happening or what is being described.
(Create pictures in your mind.)
- 8 Adjust your reading pace.
- 9 Pause to think.
- 10 Mark up the book.
(Highlight, bookmark, underline, write notes in the margin.)
- 11 Ask "Does this make sense?"
- 12 Figure out what is most important.
