PROPOSITION IF PROPOSICION PRINCIPAL

IF + Simple Present Simple Present

EXAMPLES

If you eat ice It melts.
If it rain The grass gets so wet..

CONDITIONAL ONE :

El CONDICIONAL UNO FIRST : Se emplea para referirse a presente o future, cuando la situación es real. El Condicional 1 se refiere a una condición posible y su resultado probable.

PROPOSICION IF PROPOSICION PRINCIPAL

IF + SIMPLE PRESENT WILL CAN + INFINITIVE

If you don't hurry You will miss the bus.
If you eat too much You can get fat.
