

PROPÓSITO:

PRESENT SIMPLE - SHORT TEXTS

1. Usamos presente simple para expresar hábitos, rutinas, acciones repetidas o situaciones, emociones y deseos permanentes:

For Example:

- I work in Bogota
- He brushes his teeth everyday
- she is a student
- you live in a big house.

2. También usamos este tiempo para hablar de eventos programadas y para dar instrucciones.

For Example:

- You walk for two blocks, then you turn left.
- His father arrives tomorrow.
- Cook the spaguetti when water boils.
- I have soccer practice at 2 pm.

GRAMMATICAL RULES

1. Para los sujetos (I, You, We, They) usaremos el verbo en Infinitivo.

Sujeto + **Verbo** + **Complemento**

I work in Paris

You live in a big house

We play football

2. Para los sujetos (**She, He, It**), al verbo le agregamos una "s" al final del verbo.

Sujeto + **Verbo** + **Complemento**

She lives in Cartagena.

He plays the piano.

It drinks coffee in the morning.

STRUCTURE

Affirmative:

Sujeto + **Verbo** + **(Complemento)**

You watch TV all day

She studies English.

Negative:

Sujeto + **Verbo Auxiliar Do** + **not** + **Verbo** + **(Complemento)**

We do not (don't) watch TV all day

She does not (doesn't) study English.

Interrogative:

Verbo Auxiliar Do + **Sujeto** + **Verbo** + **(Complemento)** + **?**

Do you watch TV all day?

Does she study English?

Vocabulary:

- Wake up: despertarse (I wake up at 6 am)
- Get up: levantarse (She gets at at 8:00)
- Take a shower: ducharse, bañarse (I take a shower at 8:15)
- Have breakfast: desayunar (He has breakfast at 8:30)
- Get dressed: vestirse (I get dressed at 8:45)
- Brush my teeth: cepillarse los dientes (I brush my teeth at 9:00)
- Go to work: ir al trabajo
- Go to school: ir a la escuela (My son goes to school on by bicycle)
- Have lunch: almorzar (We have lunch at noon)
- Finish work: terminar de trabajar (I finish work at 5:30)
- Go home: ir a casa (She goes home at 5:30)
- Have dinner: cenar (We have dinner at 7:00)
- Watch TV: mirar o ver televisión (He watches TV for a while)
- Go to bed: acostarse, ir a la cama (They go to bed at 10:00)
- Sleep: dormir (I sleep for 8 hours)
