Present Perfect

The present perfect tense refers to an action or state that either occurred at an indefinite time in the past (e.g., we have talked before) or began in the past and continued to the present time (e.g., he has grown impatient over the last hour). This tense is formed by have/has + the past participle.

The second conditional is a structure used to talk about impossible or imaginary situations.

For example:

- If I won a lot of money I'd travel the world.
- Where would you live if you could live anywhere in the world?
- If he didn't argue with everyone all the time, he would have a more relaxed life.
