EJEMPLOS DE LOS VERB PATTERNS CON GERUNDIO

I like running in the park. (like + gerundio)

She enjoys watching horror films. (enjoy + gerundio)

They hate going to the dentist. (hate + gerundio)

In my free time, I like going to the gym, watching films, or just meeting my friends for a drink. (like + varios gerundios)

He loves eating, but he doesn't like cooking. (love + gerundio)

La mayoría de los otros verb patterns usan to + infinitivo, o el infinitivo simplemente. Y como mencioné antes, puedes descargar mi ebook gratuito sobre los verb patterns aquí: gum.co/verbpatterns.

Y seguimos...

EL GERUNDIO COMO SUJETO DE LA FRASE

Tercero, usamos el gerundio cuando el verbo es el sujeto de la frase o tiene forma de sustantivo.

Un verbo como run habla de la acción, pero transformándolo en gerundio - running - también puede usarse como sustantivo.

Es un poco lo mismo que hacemos con los verb patterns:

I like running. (El gerundio sirve de complemento, como si fuera sustantivo.)

Aquí lo hacemos al revés, usando el gerundio como sujeto de la frase:

Running is a lot of fun.

Fíjate que en español, se usa el infinitivo para eso: Correr es muy divertido.

No es verdad, pero como ejemplo, nos sirve ????

MAS EJEMPLOS DEL GERUNDIO COMO SUJETO DE LA FRASE

Aquí tienes más ejemplos:

- Shopping is fun, but I don't have much money.
- Smoking is prohibited in the airport.
- Swimming is very healthy exercise.
- Eating too much sugar makes you fat.
- Cooking is easy. You should learn!
- Living in Madrid is more expensive than living in Lisbon.
- Working all the time is very stressful.

OTROS USOS DEL GERUNDIO EN INGLES

Cuarto (y que yo sepa, último) hay algunas palabras que son gerundios pero también son sustantivos o adjetivos con otros significados, o que se usan para formar ciertas frases importantes.

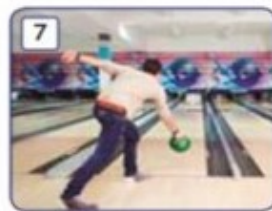
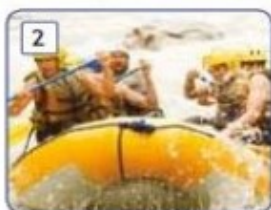
- Comparatives and superlatives: Es importante explicar que los adjetivos en inglés no tienen ni género ni número; entonces el adjetivo "Shy" (tímido /a/os/as) puede significar, dependiendo del contexto, "tímido" "tímida" "tímidas" o "tímidos".
