# Speaking naturally Intonation of tag questions

You're not sure and want to check something:

You haven't seen her show yet, have you?

You're sure and think someone will agree:

It's amazing, isn't it?

Tag questions are statements followed by short questions in the same tense, called "tags."

Affirmative statement + negative tag

It's amazing, isn't it?

That was a dumb thing to do, wasn't it? She won the talent show, didn't she? He's dropped out of sight, hasn't he?

Answer yes to agree.

She won the talent show, didn't she?
Yes, she did.

Negative statement + affirmative tag It's not easy to become famous, is it?

That wasn't too smart, was it?
She didn't have connections, did she?
His career hasn't taken off, has it?

Answer no to agree.

That wasn't too smart, was it?

No, it wasn't.



NICK I had one of my amazing dreams again last night, Jenny.

JENNY You haven't had a dream like that for a very long time, have you?

NICK No, I haven't.

JENNY It means you are very imaginative, doesn't it?
