

Comparative Adjectives

(Used to compare 2 things)

"The elephant is bigger than the mouse"



One syllable	Two syllables ending in 'y' - change 'y' to 'i' and add er	Two or more syllables
Form: <u>+er than</u>	Form: <u>+ier than</u>	Form: <u>More ... than</u>
<u>Bigger than</u> <u>Smaller than</u> <u>Nicer than</u> <u>Taller than</u> <u>Shorter than</u> <u>Stronger than</u> <u>Weaker than</u> <u>Longer than</u>	<u>Easier than</u> <u>Busier than</u> <u>Prettier than</u> <u>Heavier than</u> <u>Funnier than</u> <u>Smellier than</u> <u>Happier than</u> <u>Friendlier than</u>	<u>more beautiful than</u> <u>more dangerous than</u> <u>more intelligent than</u> <u>more understanding than</u> <u>more complex than</u> <u>more interesting than</u> <u>more difficult than</u> <u>more frustrating than</u>
