PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE

S + am/is/are + V-ing +...
He is playing.

-

S + am/is/are (not) + V-ing +...
He isn't playing.

?

Am/is/are + S + V-ing +...?
Is he playing?

+

S + was/were + V-ing
She was cooking all morning.

-

S + was/were + not + V-ing
She was not sleeping when he came home.

?

Was/were + S + V-ing?
Was she sleeping when he came home?
