• Write 10 Example what has affirmative - negative - interrogative.

Affirmative

- She has got a black cat
- we have got a New car
- you have got a pink bike
- I have been trying to figure this out
- The teachers have to be very patient
- I have to work every day
- I have to do my homework
- you have to stop smoking
- Postmen have to deliver letters
- doctors have to treat people.

Interrogative

- Has she got a black cat?
- Have we got a new car?
- Have you got a pink bike?
- She has to clean the house
- He has been thoughtful support
- He has been living with her for years
- She has been trying to get there for so long
- Each word has a first and last letter
- college has given me something greater than education.

Negative

- She hasn't got a black cat. I haven't not gone
- we haven't got a New car. I haven't got married
- you haven't got a pink bike
- I haven't visited my grandmother yet
- I haven't got any brother
- I haven't got a pet
- we haven't got a computer
- The haven't got any idea

write 10 example with Has
Affirmative - negative - Interrogative

Affirmative

- I have got a map
- You've got a car
- He has got a big house
- She got a good friend
- It has got a tail
- We have got a flat
- You have got a book
- They've got some money

Negative

- I haven't got any money
- You haven't got any brothers
- He hasn't got a pen
- She hasn't got any friends
- It hasn't got a big room
- You haven't got a laptop
- They haven't got a ticket
- He never has time to go out with me

Interrogative

- Does she have to take the children with her to Houston?
- Does he have to lend us the money which we need?
- Does she have to be back by noon?
- Does she have to return later?
- Do you have to learn at least five new words every day?
- Do you have to see her tomorrow?
- Do they have to help you with your work?
- Do you have to go by plane?
- Does it have to rain this evening?
