## USOS DEL MODAL "MUST"= DEBER

### Obligación

*I must visit my father in hospital*

### Necesidad imperiosa

*You must vaccinate your cat against rabies*

### Convencer a alguien de algo

*You must try that restaurant. It's excellent.*

## FORMA

AFFIRMATIVE: SUJETO + MUST + VERBO

I **must** study / he **must** study

NEGATIVE: SUJETO + MUSTN'T + VERBO

I **mustn't** smoke / he **mustn't** smoke

INTERROGATIVE: MUST + SUJETO + VERBO ?

**Must** I phone him ? / **Must** he go to the dentist?

SHORT ANSWER: Yes, Suj. + must / No, Suj. + mustn't

Yes, you **must** / Yes, he **must**

No, you **mustn't** / No, he **mustn't**

# MUST & SHOULD

	Obligation & Recommendation
<b>MUST</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-official, written rule You must be 18 or older to vote in the U.S.</li><li>-duty/strong moral obligation You must respect your parents.</li><li>-very strong recommendation You must visit DC when you're in the U.S.</li></ul>
<b>SHOULD</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-personal obligation / moral obligation (weaker than "must") I should save more money each month. I should call my brother more often.</li><li>-recommendation She should wear a suit to the interview.</li></ul>
<b>HAVE TO</b> <i>NOT a modal verb</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-changes form I <b>HAVE TO</b> finish this report by 5:00. She <b>HAS TO</b> finish this report by 5:00.</li><li>-often used in place of <b>MUST</b> when speaking</li><li>-necessity I <b>have to</b> wear glasses to see.</li></ul>
