WHAT TRIGGERED THE PROTESTS IN VENEZUELA?

The protests **98** in early February in the western states of Tachira and Merida when students demanded increased security after a female student **99** she had been the victim of an attempted rape. Venezuela has the fifth **100** murder rate in the world, and crime is rife in many urban centres.

The students **101** complained about record inflation (official figures suggest yearly inflation in December 2013 stood at 56.2%) and shortages of basic food items.

The protests in Tachira **102** violent, triggering the arrest of several students, which in turn led to demonstrations in Caracas **103** for their release.

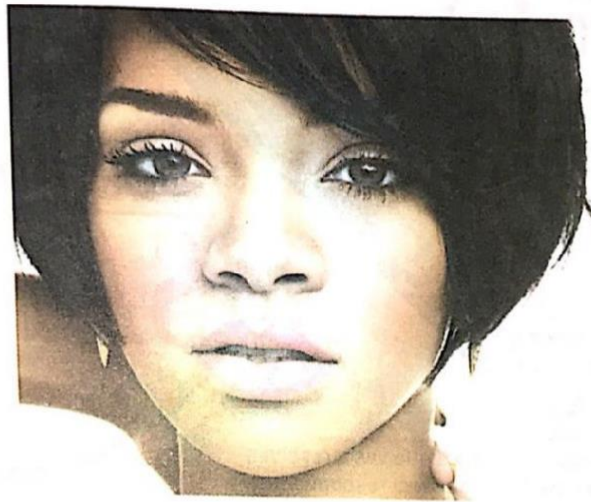

Robyn Rihanna Fenty (born February 20, 1988), known by her **118** name Rihanna is a Barbadian recording artist, actress, and fashion designer. She was born in Saint Michael, Barbados, and her career began when she met record producer Evan Rogers through mutual friends in late 2003 and recorded demo tapes **119** Rogers's guidance. Her demo tape was sent to several record labels, and she subsequently signed a contract with Def Jam Recordings after **120** for its president, rapper Jay-Z. Her debut album, *Music of the Sun* (2005) and its follow-up *A Girl Like Me* (2006) both peaked in the top ten on the Billboard 200 chart. The albums spawned the Billboard Hot 100 top two hit single "Pon de Replay" and her first Hot 100 number-one "SOS".

Her third studio album, *Good Girl Gone Bad* (2007), and its chart-topping lead single "Umbrella" were major **121** in her career that brought her to widespread prominence. The album and its Reloaded version (2008) produced the worldwide hit singles "Don't Stop the Music", "Take a Bow", and "Disturbia". The record was nominated for nine Grammy Awards, **122** Best Rap/Sung Collaboration for "Umbrella". Following a highly publicized **123** with then-boyfriend Chris Brown, she released her fourth studio album, *Rated R*, in November 2009. It was followed by three more albums: *Loud* (2010), *Talk a Penthouse Piece* (2011), and her first Billboard 200 number one album *Unapologetic* (2012). That **124** year, she appeared in her first theatrical feature film, *Battleship*.

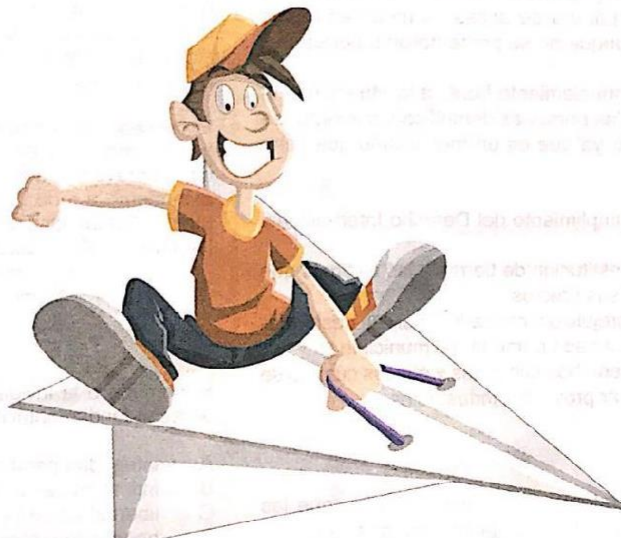
