Rosa Parks ① **was** an incredible African-American civil rights activist who ② **lived** born in Alabama, USA in 1913. Rosa ③ **started** school but stopped studying as a young teenager to look after her grandmother. As a child Rosa experienced discrimination because of her skin colour and ④ **had** in constant fear of terrible groups like the Klu Klux Klan.

At the time, laws in America were very racist and black people ⑤ **received** to sit in separate areas on buses away from white people.

On December 1, 1955, Rosa ⑥ **refused** to give up her seat to a white man. The police ⑦ **arrested** Rosa for civil disobedience and fined her \$10. Her arrest ⑧ **gave** one of the largest and most successful movements against racial segregation in history and ⑨ **attended** her an iconic status in American culture.

Over the years, Rosa ⑩ **was** many awards for her activism, including the prestigious Martin Luther King Jr. award and the Presidential Medal Of Freedom. Rosa ⑪ **died** in 2005, but ⑫ **left** us with this message: "I believe we are here on the planet Earth to live, grow up and do what we can to make this world a better place for all people to enjoy freedom."
