

### WHAT TRIGGERED THE PROTEST IN VENEZUELA?

The protests began in early February in the western states of Tachira and Mérida when students demanded increased security after a female student supposed she had been the victim of an attempted rape. Venezuela has the fifth highest murder rate in the world, and crime is rife in many urban centres.

The students too complained about record inflation (official figures suggest yearly inflation in December 2013 stood at 56.2%) and shortages of basic food ~~idea~~ items.

The protests in Tachira deranged violent, triggering the arrest of

several students, which in turn led to demonstrations in caracas calling for their release.
