PRONOUNS






Pronouns are used to refer to a specific object or person. This means that a pronoun can replace the name of a person or an object (Noun).

SUBJECT PRONOUNS





- The subject pronouns in English are:
 - I, you, he, she, it, we, they.
- Each pronoun let us discover how many people is talking or doing the action.
 For example:

<u>We</u> are playing football. ----- The pronoun "<u>we</u>" indicates that there are <u>more than 2</u> people involved in the action.
