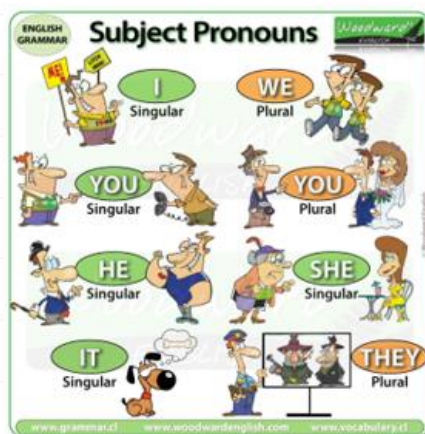
PRONOUNS



- Pronouns are used to refer to a specific object or person. This means that a pronoun can replace the name of a person or an object (Noun).
- Pronouns indicate the gender, number, or persons speaking.



SUBJECT PRONOUNS



SINGULAR		PLURAL
1 ST PERSON	I	we
2 ND PERSON	you	you
3 RD PERSON	he	they
3 RD PERSON	she	they
3 RD PERSON	it	they
he + he = they		I + you = we
she + she = they		you + you = you
he + she = they		you + you + you = you
it + it = they		you + he + she = you

- The subject pronouns in English are:
I, you, he, she, it, we, they.
- Each pronoun let us discover how many people is talking or doing the action.
For example:

We are playing football. ----- The pronoun "we" indicates that there are more than 2 people involved in the action.

We use **subject pronouns** as the subject of a **verb**. We use **subject pronouns** before **verbs**.
