

INDEFINITE FREQUENCY



ADVERB OF FREQUENCY

EXAMPLES

100% Always

90% Usually

80% Normally / Generally

70% Often / Frequently

50% Sometimes

30% Occasionally

10% Seldom

5% Hardly ever / Rarely

APPROXIMATE NUMBERS

0% Never

I always brush my teeth at night.
I usually walk to work.
I normally get good marks.
I often read in bed at night.
I sometimes sing in the shower.
I occasionally go to bed late.
I seldom add salt to my food.
I hardly ever get angry.
Vegetarians never eat meat.








AFTER THE VERB TO BE HOW?












BEFORE A MAIN VERB







We use hardly ever and never with positive, not negative verbs:


- · She hardly ever comes to my parties.
- They never say 'thank you'.

We use ever in questions and negative statements:

- · Have you ever been to New Zealand?
- · I haven't ever been to Switzerland. (The same as 'I have never been Switzerland').










