Today Matt Damon is one of Hollywood's most famous movie stars. But in the early 1990s he was struggling to be a success, and, over the years, life has not always been easy.



In 1996, he had to lose 40 pounds for his role as a drug-addicted soldier in *Courage under Fire*. While he was dieting, he became ill and had to take medication for several years afterwards.

In 2000, he cracked a rib while he was playing golf in *The Legend of Bagger Vance*. Then, 12 years after losing weight for *Courage under Fire*, he had to gain 30 pounds to play a businessman in *The Informant*.

Matt grew up in Massachusetts in the U.S. and **started** acting while he **was** still a student. He was studying English at Harvard University when he got a part in the movie *Geronimo*.

An American Legend. When he heard the good news, he immediately **dropped** out of Harvard, hoping that Hollywood would take notice of him. It didn't. It wasn't until he won an Oscar with his friend, Ben Affleck, for *Good Will Hunting* in 1997 that Hollywood **began** to show interest. After excellent performances in *The Talented Mr. Ripley*, *Saving Private Ryan*, and *Ocean's 11*, he was **offered** the lead role in 2002 as the assassin Jason Bourne in *The Bourne Identity*. From then on, his career **moved** in one direction only - upward.
